## **Health and Safety Reminders**

- With the nicer weather, we are so glad to see many students and families riding their bicycles and scooters to school. For everyone's safety, <u>please remember to walk them as soon as you arrive on school grounds</u>. Please use the PAC purchased bike and scooter racks to lock them.
- Drivers, please do not enter the cul-de-sac on Allan for drop-off/pick-up.
- Drivers, please do not enter the cul-de-sac on Bushnell past the crosswalk for drop-off/pick-up
- Continue to be respectful of our neighbours by not blocking their driveways, and following all posted signage.

- Continue to practice healthy hand hygiene and respiratory etiquette (careful coughing and sneezing).
