Student Placement 2022-2023

Last week, we sent information home about the class placement process for 2022-23. At this time of year, the staff are reviewing the current school year and making plans for the following year. At this stage in our planning, we are looking at a tentative organization and assignment of students to classes for the 2022-2023 school year. Student placement is a thoughtful and collaborative process that seeks to consider each child's social, emotional and academic needs while creating balanced and effective learning environments. The assignment of students to classes is decided by a team, which includes a child's current teacher, non-enrolling teachers, the School Based Resource Team, and the administrators. This professional team considers each placement carefully as they work to create classes that include a wide range of students who learn in a variety of ways.

If you have information that the current classroom teacher and/or the principal does not have and that you feel should be considered when placing

your child, please submit this information using the form below on or before, Friday, May 27th, 2022. The information that you provide about your child's individual needs will be will be shared with the team and will be considered as we work to create educationally sound and balanced classes.

Our goal is to meet the needs of all students at Ross Road in order to maximize their growth as learners. Please know that a great deal of thought and care will be taken throughout this complex and important process.
