Reminder: School Supplies for 2022-23

At Ross Road, the primary teachers (<u>Kindergarten to Grade 3</u>) purchase all the required school supplies in bulk for the students in their classes. This helps ensure all children have the same supplies. In September, a form will go home with primary students with instructions on how to pay for the school supplies (cost is \$50). If you wish to purchase your own supplies, please contact the school for a list.

If ordering from Creative Packs, please include your child's current division number.

Part A: The essential pack with items chosen by your teacher/school. This comes as a package deal with all items listed included. Items cannot be changed, substituted, or omitted.

Part B items: You MUST have all Part B items. Individual items may be purchased from Creative Packs by adding them to your Pack order or bring them in from home.

Part C items are optional.

Part B and/or C items must be ordered at the SAME TIME as the Part A pack. You may not order Part B or C items at a later date.

Payment types accepted are VISA & MasterCard, or prepaid VISA or prepaid MasterCard.

Ordering Deadlines

- Packs ordered before Monday, July 4th receive free shipping to the school.
 - These will be distributed by the school to your child upon their return in September.
- Packs ordered after Monday, July 4th will pay a \$12.00 home delivery charge.
