- Students will be dismissed at 10:43 from last year's classroom.
- New students will be dismissed from the main entrance to parent/quardian.

### Wednesday, September 7

- Grade 1-7 students attend for the full day 8:43-2:50pm (first bell rings at 8:38am).
- Students return to the classroom they were in on Tuesday, September 6.
- Send a snack, water bottle, lunch and school supplies.
- School supplies purchased via the school will be distributed to students.
- **New students** should go to the outside meeting spot for the classroom they were taken to yesterday.
- **Kindergarten** students follow the gradual entry schedule.
- We anticipate students in grade 1-7 moving to new classes today or tomorrow.
- Please arrange a meeting spot to pick your child up from at the end of the day.

- Grade 1-7 students attend from 8:43 2:50pm (first bell rings at 8:38am)
- Students will need their school supplies, snack and a lunch for these days.
- Please arrange a meeting spot to pick up your child from at the end of the day.
