The demonstration will be done by a professional and students should not attempt anything without proper training. Parents and guardians should review safety rules with children carefully.

Thursday, the primary grades will be inspiring creativity and wonder in us all by designing their own bikes.

Friday, the winning class for the bike tally will be announced, with a prize!
