Monday Message

Dear Ross Road Families,

Students and staff have had a great first week at school. September is a busy and exciting time for everyone. At Ross Road, we acknowledge that social emotional learning sets the foundation for personal, social and intellectual growth and we are committed to working together to provide a caring and compassionate school environment for all children. Students are settling in and we are working on establishing routines, understandings and relationships that will help us experience a successful year of learning.

Today, we reviewed the Code of Conduct and important school rules and heard about how everyone can help make Ross Road a kind, caring and inclusive place. The Ross Road handbook, including the Code of Conduct and other important information, can be located on the school website as well as inside student agendas. You are encouraged to review it with your child.

For those of you new to Ross Road, we will be sending home a weekly communication called "The Monday Message". It includes important updates and information we wish to share as well as a look ahead at important upcoming dates.

Logging student absences or lates

Ensuring students arrive safely at school each day is one of our top priorities. Ross Road Elementary uses SafeArrival, which is part of the SchoolMessenger platform, for parents/guardians to report student absences. Using the SchoolMessenger app makes it quick and easy to report your child's absence (eg. illness, vacation, appointment), reduces the time it takes school staff to verify student attendance, and makes it more efficient for staff to respond to unreported student absences.

With SafeArrival, you are able to report your child's absence *in advance* using any of these three options, which are available to you 24 hours/day, 7 days a week:

- SchoolMessenger app. Use your mobile device to download the SchoolMessenger app, available at the Apple App Store, the Google Play Store or go.schoolmessenger.ca.
- The first time you use the app, select **Sign Up** to create your account. <u>Important</u>: Use the same email address your school has on record.
- Select Attendance, then Report an Absence.
- **SchoolMessenger website**. Open your browser and go to go.schoolmessenger.ca.
- The first time you use the website, select **Sign Up** to create your account. <u>Important</u>: Use the same email address your school has on record.
- Select **Attendance**, then **Report an Absence**.
- **Automated phone system**. Call the toll-free number 1-833-259-7295 and follow the promptsto report an absence.

SafeArrival is the preferred method to report your child's absence, late arrival, or early dismissal in advance. If you are unable to use SafeArrival, please call 604-903-3755 to report the absence. *Please note SafeArrival is not checked after 9am each day. To log an absence after 9am for that day, please call the office.

Student permission forms

This week students will bring home a package that includes many important documents and forms for completion. Please return these to the classroom teacher no later than **September 22nd**. We appreciate your support with these important documents. Please also remember to complete the forms in your <u>school cash online</u>. This is a reminder to please follow posted signage and speed limits. The student pick-up/ drop-off area is not for parking in. If your child(ren) need(s) to be picked up from or walked to class by an adult, please find a suitable parking spot. The area on Bushnell in front of the playground is for students to hop out independently and walk to class. There is no pick-up or drop-off on Allan Road as per the posted signage.
