It describes individualized goals, adaptations or modifications, and the universal and essential supports to be provided; it also includes measures for tracking progress.

- Why school districts across the province are switching to Competency Based IEPs.
- What is the same and what is different from the current IEP to a Competency Based IEP.
- The main components of the Competency Based IEP.
