Monday Message

Dear Ross Road Families,

With the darker days, it is important that you review with your child the best way to travel to school safely. Drivers, please be cautious for pedestrians and do not park blocking intersections or crosswalks. Students are encouraged to travel to school with others, remain on the sidewalk, or on marked trails, and use cross-walks to cross the street. They should be vigilant and remove noise cancelling headphones. Students are reminded to walk bikes, scooters, and skateboards as they cross the street after first stopping to make eye-contact with the driver before proceeding into the intersection. Please also make sure your child knows to stay away from water such as Hastings creek. It is also helpful if they know what to do if they should come across a bear, coyote or other wildlife. A map was created that outlines the best walking routes to Ross Road and suggestions for 'Drive to 5' for those that need to drive students.

# Important Reminder: Halloween Safety at Ross Road

This is a reminder to please be thoughtful when planning for Halloween. We are seeking to partner with you to ensure this holiday is safe and fun for everyone. As we honour diversity, we want our learning environments to be places where everyone feels safe, included, respected, and valued. <u>Please</u> read the <u>letter</u> sent from the Superintendent on Oct 19, 2023.

- Costumes will be permitted at school on Tuesday Oct 3st. Students may come dressed in costume as there will be no opportunity to change during the school day.
- Please DO NOT send items that could be damaged during the day.
- As we are an Elementary school, please be mindful NOT to wear costumes that are overly scary or gory. No masks are permitted to be worn at any time.
- Replica weapons of any kind (e.g., guns, knives, handcuffs, chains etc.) are not allowed.
- Students should be easily recognizable and/or able to identify themselves to any staff member when asked. Therefore, students' faces must be visible at all times.
- Costumes that are offensive in any way will not be allowed. Please consider the rights maintained in the Canadian Human Rights Act when selecting costumes.
- The Ross Road code of conduct must always be followed, even when in costume. This includes maintaining respectful and appropriate behaviour with others and with school property.
