Term 2 Learning Updates will be published to the MyEducation BC Parent/Guardian Portal on March 12.

Learning Updates will be removed from the MyEducation BC system on July 31, 2025, so please ensure you have accessed your child(ren)'s learning update and saved or printed a copy for your records by then. Passwords are required to be reset every three months as per the regulations set out by the Ministry of Education and FIPPA (Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act). Please see instructions to reset password below:

- Log into MyEducation BC using this link (https://www.myeducation.gov.bc.ca/aspen/logon.do)
- 2. Login is your email address (the same one you provided to the school)
- Type in the password you used to access Term 1 reports. If this is successful, a message box may pop up immediately asking you to reset your password. Create a new password with the following criteria:
- 4. 8 minimum, 14 maximum characters
- 5. 1 capital letter, 1 lowercase letter
- 6. 1 number
- 7. 1 special character: # or \$ or _
- 8. Cannot contain the password, first name, middle name, last name date of birth, personal ID or sequential letters or numbers. If you have forgotten your password click on "I forgot my password" and you will be emailed a new temporary password. DO NOT copy/paste the password you must manually enter it.
- 9. Ten unsuccessful attempts will disable your account. It may take approximately half a day for it to be re-enabled.
- 10. Home computers may have unique restrictions. If you experience difficulties, try another web browser such as Chrome, Internet Explorer, Firefox, Safari, Opera, MS Edge. One of these may be the reason you cannot login or are having trouble viewing items.
- 11. If you login and do not see a learning update, it may be because you have logged in before it is published.

We are happy to share that our 2025 SD44 Chess Championship is happening again on Monday, May 5th (Pro-D day) and will take place at Sutherland Secondary. The tournament will start at 9 am and should be done by 3 pm if students advance to the finals.

Students can compete in the Primary, Intermediate or Secondary divisions. Students can register in an older division if they wish, but they cannot register in a younger division.

The top three finishers in each division will receive prizes. All participants will be encouraged to bring lunch and snacks. Parents/guardians are welcome to stay and spectate.

To ensure we can finish the tournament on time, we will limit participants to 40 Primary students, 50 Intermediate students, and 32 for the secondary division.

There is no cost for students to participate, and the tournament is open to all SD44 students K-12, and all skill levels are welcome.

With chess' growing popularity, registration fills up fairly quickly; once we have reached capacity, students will be added to a waitlist.
