Ross Road students will be sitting in **Section E** this year, and they are expected to stay together there while waiting for their events to be called.

Upon arrival at the meet, participants must find **Mme Capelle** and sign in. When they have completed their events and are ready to leave, students must find Mme Capelle to sign out, and they must show Mme Capelle the adult who is taking them.

Students should bring: water bottle, jacket, hat, snacks, lunch, proper footwear and gym strip. They will be provided with a Ross Road jersey that they should return before departing. The meet will go ahead rain or shine, so dress for the weather.
