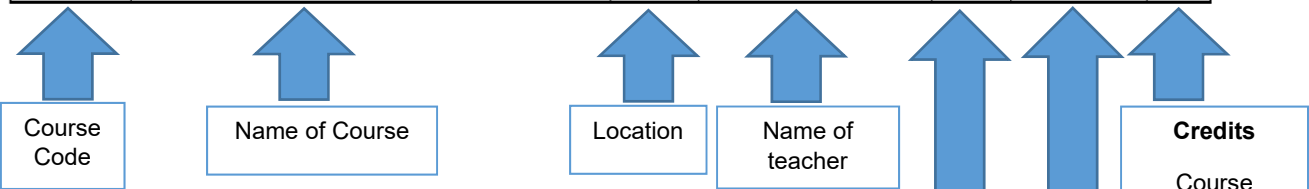


# Reading my Student Timetable

Below is an illustration to explain how to read your timetable. All secondary schools have a Day 1 and Day 2 rotation. Seycove has taken it a step further. Within the Day 1 and Day 2 rotation are actually 3 rotations making the complete block rotation a 6 day cycle; 1234 (Day 1), 5678 (Day 2), 2314 (Day 3), 6758 (Day 4), 3124 (Day 5), 7568 (Day 6).

**FY = Full Year; TRI 1, 2, or 3 = Trimester**

FY are courses that take place for the full year.

TRI courses take place for approximately 3 months

TRI 1 = Sept to Nov

TRI 2 = Dec to March

TRI 3 = March to June

**Credits**

Course credits are only required for grade 10-12 students for graduation.

**Period and (Day)**

Period corresponds to the time of day the course takes place. The number in the parenthesis refers to the daily rotation, 1 through 6. For example, the Science 8 course takes place Period 4(2,4,6). Science class takes place the last period of Day 2, 4 and 6. Music and Work Experience courses may be taken outside of the regular timetable.
