****IMPORTANT CHANGES FROM SEPTEMBER 2018****

1. Teams unable to meet the minimum number of athletes registered as well as teams without a sanctioned coach will not run. A club may run in its place.
2. Students who have quit a sport in the past calendar year and are wishing to participate in a Fall, Winter or Spring sport in 2018/2019 are subject to final approval by the Athletic Coordinators and team coach in order to participate on the desired team.
3. Student-athletes are required to perform to the best of their ability in the classroom. They are also required to: be on time and attend all classes, see teachers to complete tests and assignments missed due to team activities, and to maintain the best possible academic standing in all of their classes. Failure to abide by these expectations may result in: loss of playing time, the student being benched, possible suspension, and/or removal from the team.
4. Any student selected to a final roster that quits a team will not be reimbursed the cost of registration fees, including tournaments and the Seycove Athletic fee. Injuries are the exception and will be discussed on a case-by-case standing at the end of the season.
5. **Thursday, May 30th, 2019:** The Seycove Athletics Department will be hosting the first annual Awards Gala at the Seymour Golf and Country Club. A one time \$15.00 ticket cost per student will be built into all 2018-2019 Seycove Athletics budgets. If the athlete does not wish to attend the awards gala they may opt out of purchasing a ticket and can pay the total amount for their sport minus the \$15.00 cost. If a student has already paid the \$15.00 ticket charge for participating in a Fall or Winter sport, then please do not pay the \$15.00 again. The banquet ticket is a one time fee.
