

Dear Seycove Families of Grade 8 Students,

We hope that your summer included rest, relaxation, adventure and family activities. As we look ahead to September and our plans to welcome new students to Seycove, we want to share the schedule for the first day, as well as information about our timetable, calendar, and Grade 8 retreat at the Cheakamus Centre.

First Day of School – September 2, 2025

Grade 8 students are expected to be in attendance between 10:30am and 12:30pm, (grades 9-12 will be scheduled to attend briefly in the afternoon). Grade 8 students will meet in the gym for an orientation which will be followed by a homeroom where they will receive their timetable and locker. Next, there will be a chance for grade 8s to find the location of their first class on Wednesday so they know where they will be going the next day. We will finish the morning with grade 8s returning to their homeroom for noon where student leaders will take each homeroom group out to the field for a group activity organized by senior student leaders. The first day of regular classes is Wednesday September 3 and the block rotation will be 2,3,1,4. Students need to bring a binder, with lined paper, pens, pencils, and highlighters. Any other specific materials required by teachers will be shared in classes by the teachers. Please review and remind with your Grade 8 that students are expected to leave their personal digital devices at home or in their lockers during instructional time.

Grade 8 Retreat

We are very excited to be planning a one-day retreat at the Cheakamus Centre for all grade 8 students on Friday, October 3, 2025. This will be an important community-building experience for all our incoming Grade 8s. Seycove staff and senior student leaders are looking forward to leading parts of the programming and participating in the retreat alongside the Grade 8s.

Throughout the day, students will participate in community-building and outdoor education-based activities led by both Seycove and Cheakamus Centre staff. Student leaders, Seycove Staff and Cheakamus staff and administration will always be on site.

The cost of the trip will be \$125 per student. This includes bus transportation, all meals, and programing. More detailed information about the field trip, as well as consent forms and medical forms, are attached, and due back to the school office in the first week on Friday September 5, 2025.

Our hope is that all Grade 8 students attend the retreat. Regular grade 8 classes will not be running on the day of the retreat; therefore, students will not be missing any of their subject classes during this time. Students in academies will be excused from their classes at other school sites while at Cheakamus, and we hope that you are able to adjust after school activities to allow your child to attend this important grade-wide event.
