I hope this email finds you well. I hope you received the prior e-mail that was sent to you all outlining the trip, what it is, where they are going, and what they can expect. This e-mail will contain the forms that need to be filled out and turned in, as well as the link to the online waiver form. If you did not receive the first e-mail, please let me know and I can forward to you. You can e-mail seycovedrygrad2019@gmail.com to request any information.

Currently Kumsheen has 40 spots for us. So as it stands, the first 40 students to get their online waiver forms signed, risk and responsibility forms, medical information and cheques turned into the office will be confirmed. If we get more than 40, we will will open a waiting list and contact Kumsheen to see if they are able to accommodate us. In the past, it has been typical to get about half of the class for this trip.I'm sure Kumsheen will have room for more, this was just a start!

The price for this trip is \$330.00 and is all inclusive. It includes the BBQ fee for the class BBQ event, all transportation to and from Kumsheen, all meals while we are there and use of all facilities at the rafting resort. The resort supplies wet and dry suits so the time on the river is a comfortable one regardless of the weather. The fee also includes a pizza late night snack at the hotel before we leave and water for the bus. Water bottles are strongly recommended for the trip as well. The kids can fill those at the resort and they will be happy to have them.

Please print and fill out the forms that are attached to this e-mail. They can be dropped off at the office. Your spot will be reserved once all forms are collected, the online waiver is signed and the cheque is received.

Below you will find the link to the online waiver form and all other forms are attached to this e-mail. If you are ONLY going to the BBQ, please write a cheque for the 10 dollars and bring it to the office by June 3 with your choice of food attached to the cheque.

The BBQ is something that is held every year like the rafting. It is for all students, whether you rafted or not. It is held the evening we return from the rafting trip. You can find more information on the pdf attached. The kids get together as a class one last time, have some food and sign yearbooks. The rafters are usually exhausted so the event lasts for a couple of hours, it is not a long event.

The deadline for all forms to be turned in is June 3. This is a hard deadline. All numbers will be finalized by that date.

I have also had a few questions about kids attending the rafting if they are not going to the dinner dance. The reason we do this rafting event is to provide a fun trip for the kids to do right after grad, together, that eliminates all possibilities of kids getting into anything that may cause harm. When they leave from the hotel, it is a bit easier as they have been with their parents all night dancing and having fun without too much of an opportunity to possibly do some of the things this event tries to eliminate. Everyone has to turn in forms. One of them includes expectations for behaviour. For students who do not attend the dinner/dance, I do want to make it clear that if there is any suspicion of alcohol or drugs having been used, they will not be allowed on the bus. That would go against anything and everything this event stands for.
