Assignment Overview:

This activity is designed to help you reflect on your experience during Take Our Kids to Work Day. Whether you visited a workplace, attended a community event, or explored careers online, this assignment will help you think about your interests, skills, and future career possibilities. Choose one of the following 4 options as your Reflection. You will need to complete this on a separate piece of paper or modify this doc as needed:

Option 1: Career Pathway Interview (100-200 words)

Interview the adult you shadowed or someone working in a career you're curious about.

Ask at least three of the following questions and summarize their responses:

- What is your job title and what do you do day-to-day?
- What education or training did you need for this job?
- What do you enjoy most about your job?
- What are some challenges in your work?
- What advice would you give to someone interested in this career?

Include one photo or drawing that represents the work environment you visited or learned about. This could be:

- A picture of the workspace (with permission)
- A sketch of tools or equipment used
