Student Course Request Verification

Dear Parent/Guardian

April 27th, 2018

This is a reminder for you and your child to review the requested courses for the 2018-2019 school year on the verification sheet provided. It is important to note that this is a list of courses requested, and is NOT your student's timetable for next year. Course offerings are subject to change based on enrolment. As well, students may not be able to receive all requested courses due to scheduling conflicts.

A few very important points to consider:

- Given the increasing complexity of the timetabling process, course changes will most likely not be possible in September, 2018, so it is imperative that students verify their courses now.
- For Students in grades 11 and 12, **it is critical that you look at entrance requirements for post-secondary programs NOW** to make sure you are making informed decisions about your requested courses.
- Grade 12 students are required to take **a minimum of 6 courses**. Students who are requesting a study block must complete the application form and submit it to the appropriate counsellor for approval by admin.
- Students accepted into an **Academy, or Peak Performance**, may not be programmed into these courses at this time. These courses will be added to their timetable over the summer. Students requesting Peak Performance are required to submit an application to their counsellor each year.

Once you have reviewed your requests, please indicate any requested changes on the verification form and submit it to the appropriate grade counsellor for next year:
