Hello Seycove Families!

RE: Accessing the School for Personal Belongings:

As communicated in Friday's message, students will have access to the school on **THURSDAY, April 9th** to access their lockers pick up their personal belongings from their lockers and drop off library books.

Our students' personal safety matters to us. The schedule and all considerations have been designed to align with best practice as communicated by the Provincial Health Officer in minimizing any potential risks associated with the COVID-19 pandemic. At this time, we ask that you review with your child that the following measures must be adhered to not only for their own personal safety but for the safety of everyone else in the building:

1. Only current Seycove students will be allowed to access the school (no parents, guardians, siblings from other schools, etc. will be permitted).
2. Access will be through the Front entrance doors by the library. Students are to exit through the back doors by the music room.
3. While lining up and while in the building, students must maintain the required 2m apart as outlined in provincial social distancing protocols.
4. Parents are asked to drop off your children at the front of the school and make your way to the back parking lot for pick up. We are relying on our parents to whisk our students away once they exit the school to allow continual flow of traffic and avoid congestion.
5. Coming to the school **IS NOT** mandatory. If you have no need to come, then stay home. This is **not** a mandatory locker cleanout. If there is nothing that your child needs from their locker, **please don't come**. This is not an opportunity to connect with staff as they are not in the building, nor is it a time to socialize. It is time to collect items from lockers if they are needed at home.
6. No washrooms, classroom access, or garbage bags will be available.
7. Students bring bags/backpacks from home to collect items to take home.
8. Once the locker is empty, students are asked to leave the door open but with the lock attached to the handle. This will help our custodial staff with their cleaning. Locker doors and handles will be disinfected after the locker is emptied.

9. We ask all students to respect this process, only accessing the school during their scheduled time. Students are asked to enter the building, gather their belongings, exit immediately, and go directly home. Students who do not comply with staff instruction will be asked to leave immediately and will not be allowed to access the building.
10. There will also be a labeled bin in front of the library for students to return library books. Students will not be able to sign out books.
11. Please wash your hands prior to coming to the school.
- 12. Do not come to the school if you are sick, if you are under self-isolation rules due to travel or have been exposed to others who are at a high risk of having COVID-19.**
