

Dropping your child off at Seycove ... COVID edition:

Now that the wetter weather is here to stay, we need to adjust some of our guidelines for students arriving at Seycove, and then entering the school. There was a significant increase in the volume of cars today, and as a result I have many concerns over traffic, and student safety. Please go over this carefully with your child, and anyone who will be driving to the school.

Students Arriving on foot (all grades):

If a student is arriving at Seycove on foot (the preferred way) nothing changes ... students have been instructed to enter the school by the door closest to their classroom.

Students Arriving by car (see grade entrance assignments below):

If, however, you are dropping your child off by car, we ask that you take a careful look at map below, and then students are to enter the school as described:

- Grade 8 and 9 only: enter the lower cafeteria doors and follow the signs
- Grade 10: enter by the door next to the music rooms
- Grade 11/12: enter by the portables

DO NOT take short cuts by using the wrong entrance. **DO NOT** walk up the lane to the front of the school, it is not safe to do so. We are separating the cohorts for safety reasons. These entrances have been assigned to reduce traffic congestion and maintain our grade cohorts.

Again, walking to school is preferable. If you are worried about getting wet, bring an umbrella.

Once you are in the building, go directly to your class. We are asking students to arrive at 09:30. If the classroom door is not open, or you are a bit early, line up in the hallway following physical distancing guidelines, do not clump together.

Remember, these guidelines are in place so we can continue to be safe and be in school together!
