# Re: Course Programming Process and Parent Information Evenings for Grades 9-12

The purpose of these meetings is to review the process for students to select courses for the 2022-2023 school year and to provide an overview to parents on factors to consider when you are assisting your student(s) with their course selection decisions.

The course programming process is multi-faceted and requires careful consideration and planning. After our counsellors have provided initial information to parents and students, we request that you continue to discuss various course options, consider student strengths and interests, talk to Seycove teachers about their course offerings (content, topics, rigor, etc.), contact post-secondary intuitions for admission requirements if necessary, and ask clarifying questions of school counsellors.
