Good evening!

Once again, there is more good news about COVID. As you know, the B.C. government announced a <u>four-step restart plan</u> to bring people back together safely.

However, it is extremely important to note that with respect to the K-12 public education system, the current health and safety protocols for K-12 in-person instruction at Stage 2 will remain in effect for the remainder of the 2020/2021 school year. *To clarify, there will be no changes/adjustments to existing protocols at Seycove.* 

As announced last week, Health Canada approved the use of the Pfizer vaccine for youth aged 12 to 17, and students are now eligible to register and get vaccinated against COVID-19.
