VP Report

Pam notes that on the first day back, many older students were helpful with the incoming grade 8s, would like to see this actively encouraged as a routine at Seycove. Grade 8 parent night drew app. 35 parents. If this event were postponed by a week or so in future the attendance might grow. Pam was formerly at Carson Graham Secondary for 10 years.

Athletics:

Darcy Grant and Geoff Russell's Athletic Council plan to continue to work closely with PAC. Darcy describes the progress in the weight room; all unuseful equipment has been cleared and new platforms for weight equipment have been constructed. The newly refurbished room should fit a class of 20-30 students. Darcy and Geoff have put thought and energy into the creation of graphic banners. A total of four banners featuring athletic photography and inspirational quotes will hang in the gym.

The Athletic Council will have extensive information for students and parents on the Seycove website. Darcy and Geoff welcome the presence of PAC members on the Council. The Council will also meet with other coaches to determine various wish lists, which will then be brought to PAC and admin. Many individuals volunteer as coaches and the hope is that the school budget can cover expenses that volunteers often cover out of their own pockets. More teams are qualifying for tournaments which involves travel expenses, causing a growth in budget needs. Any individual wishing to grow their coaching skills can speak to the Athletic Dept with advice and encouragement. All school sports teams participating in the fall season have new uniforms. Darcy and Geoff have set as a priority new uniforms for XC and Track but many other teams need uniforms replaced.
