**Indigenous Ed- New Grad Requirement for current Grade 10s (2024)**

**Proposed Implementation Timeline**

The proposed change to the graduation program includes a phased-in implementation:

**2021-2022**

- Consultation and communication with education partners about how best to implement the change to the graduation program
- School districts and independent schools begin to prepare for any necessary capacity building in school districts and schools

**2022-2023**

- Continued communication with education partners
- Where existing courses are in place, students in Grades 10 and 11 *may* complete courses that meet the Indigenous-focused graduation requirement
- School districts and independent schools increase capacity to offer the courses *(teacher professional learning and gathering of any needed resources)*

**2023-2024**

- The change to the Graduation Program would take **full effect** for students graduating beginning 2023-2024

-have been meeting with ENG and SS dep't and considering offering it to all Gr 11's next year. It will impact elective options so we'd have to revisit course programming. Would replace ENG 12 but the University requirements are not changing. There will be communication to Gr 10 parents early next week once we find out more info.

**Attendance**

-school is preparing to send home letters reminding parents and students of effect of poor attendance. The counsellors will work closely with students to find out how they can support better attendance. Seems the Gr 12's have checked out and the the Gr 10 group are often late for the pm block. It seems the pattern has got worse since Covid.
