3. Principal's report
 - Support for kids at risk of failing. Counsellors email out to teacher's that students 60% and below are identified for review and completion – last week of June. Pam is following up with teachers to ensure that this process is followed - counsellors and LAC teachers come up with the plan of action to ensure that kids know what they need to do while they are in school, versus sending work home.
 - Vice Principal went out to articulation – with grade 7 teachers, overview of the class to assist with planning for next week.
 - Pro-D – school-based, flipped it this time with curriculum competencies in AM and guest speaker in PM. Teachers are to agree upon key concepts and then develop a course outline that will be shared online, across each year. Station work for groups of teachers included; core competencies, assessment etc... where they focused on the highlights, lowlights, areas of tension and areas that are exciting at each station.
 - Windy Cove – Director of Instruction Joanne Robertson to share school plans and goals across FOS. Seycove has 3 key goals:
 1. New Curriculum: core competencies (this year)
 2. Engagement: lack of engagement from staff and students: trial flex time
 3. Supporting Diversity: learning styles, backgrounds, SOGI, adaptations & modifications for students with IEPs etc...
 - April staff meeting – activity to represent diversity
 - Our school survey – 3-5 year license – has been completed for the last 4 years. Pam is reviewing the data. Social-emotional, academics, physical fitness ... students will be completing this soon.
 - VCH survey – 2 grade 8 classes, 2 grade 9 classes, 2 grade 10 classes, 2 grade 11 classes, 1 grade 12 class – Community Health Nurse oversees the survey sessions
 - Blanket exercise – 85 students + all grade 10s, and some from Social Justice class attended. Hosted for parents in evening. Small group, but high engagement.
 - Early dismissal Friday
 - Core Competencies – end of May, so all parents have access first week of June. Not a report card, but a self-evaluation of where students feel they are at. Levelled 1-10, not by grade, but by experience. Notice, name, nurture. Gr 8-9 Rob, Gr 10-11 Pam – oversee the sessions in the computer lab. In other schools, teachers are doing it in class. At Seycove, the approach is to ensure that students share examples from all areas and therefore not have assessment completed in one particular class. 80 minutes set aside – need to log on into the portal. Also have access from home to finish it if not completed during computer lab time. Instruction will be

projected for the students along with an instruction sheet handout. IEP students – get started and then given time in LAC block to finish. Parents can log on 2nd week of June. Pam/Rob and parents will review it. Pull them in Sept, maybe look at a flex block for students to set new goals based on the last entry.

- Numeracy test – communication sent to families at beginning of school year & communication to go out again soon to parents – assessment is the last week in June Mon-Tues-Wed by last name.
- SOGI Survey email will go out from Pam with a link to news article, seeking feedback re: rainbow crosswalk – opportunity for final input from Seycove community.
- Mr. Braam retired – teacher hired

5. DPAC Report – low attendance with blanket exercise offered to the parent community, looking at offering it again
