Are your immunizations up-to-date?



Students - please review your immunization history. Make sure all your immunizations are up-to-date before you graduate!

DID YOU KNOW

- Vaccines are a healthy choice for you.
- They provide immunity and prevent disease.
- Prior to entering some universities, colleges, and workplaces, you may be required to submit your immunization records.

By Grade 12, students should have the following Provincially funded vaccines:

✓ Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis (Whooping Cough), Polio

✓ Hepatitis B

✓ HPV (Human Papillomavirus)*

* All girls born 1994 or later are still eligible for the HPV vaccine if they have not received it.

✓ Meningococcal C

✓ MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)

✓ Varicella (Chickenpox)
