# Grad Write Ups for Graduation Ceremony - STUDENT ACTION REQUIRED

DUE: FRIDAY, APRIL 18, 2025

Students must use the link on their own account and submit their write up.

Grad write-ups are read as students cross the stage to shake the principal's hand and receive their diploma on May 29th. Write ups are meant to be formal, articulate, and concise at only 50 to 60 words.

This is mandatory for ALL grads. If we don't have a personalised write up, we will write something (impersonal) on behalf of grads as they walk across the stage. #### **Driving and Behaviour at Seycove**

I wanted to include the message that was sent out to all grads last week, after witnessing some concerning and irresponsible driving and decision-making around vehicles at and at the school. As mentioned in my introduction, we appreciate the support form home in having conversations with your kids about the responsibility of driving and of having passengers in cars. If we continue to see such behaviour around cars at school, we will inform parents and guardians asap.











#### Grade 12s,

I wanted to take a moment to address something that is quite serious to me - and to other staff and students at Seycove. Since returning from Spring Break, I have deep concerns regarding unsafe driving behaviour in our school parking lot and around the school.

Recently, we have observed incidents involving speeding, overcrowded vehicles, reckless stunts—including individuals riding on top of cars—and general poor decision-making behind the wheel. These choices are not only dangerous for yourselves and other students, but they also show a lack of readiness to take on the responsibility that comes with driving.

Let us be clear: driving is a privilege, not a right. If you are unable to demonstrate safe and respectful behaviour while behind the wheel, that privilege can—and will—be removed. From this point forward, any unsafe driving will result in immediate consequences. This includes notifying your parents and the RCMP and may include having vehicles towed at the owner's expense, if vehicles are parked at the school.

We care deeply about your safety and the safety of others in our community. Please make better choices if you are opting to take on the responsibility of driving—or getting into cars with other friends who are behind the wheel.

I want to make sure everyone is able to graduate and to participate in grad activities - and this happens with good conduct at the school. More importantly even, that you are able to attend because you have made safe and responsible decision making over the next few pivotal weeks (and beyond).
