**Important Update on Grade 12 Literacy Graduation Assessment

A message from the Ministry of Education:

November Graduation Assessment Administration Session CANCELLED

Due to BC General Employees' Union (BCGEU) strike action in the BC Public Service, the Graduation Assessment Session for November 3-7, 2025, will be cancelled for all grade 10 and 12 assessments. The next available session will begin in January 2026.

The Ministry has confirmed that early admission to post-secondary institutions in B.C. will not be impacted by the cancellation, as students are able to write the assessments in another session and submit their results when completed.

All Seycove Grade 12 Literacy Assessments are now rescheduled for January 19th, 20th, and 21st, 2026.

A reminder that all grade 12s are required to write all three Provincial Graduation Assessments to graduate with a Dogwood as a part of the BC Grad Program. Please ensure grads plan accordingly to be present for this assessment as it is a necessary step toward graduation. Mr. Ruben will send out more information about the assessments closer to the date. If students have missed the previous Literacy 10 or Numeracy 10 Assessments, they can write these in January and/or April. Please ensure grads are checking the Grade 12 MS Scholarship Team – there will be lots of information about grad and general school information posted here, so it's important for students to check often.
