	Students must book an "Individual" sitting to get their photo taken, but are also able to have family and pets join them if they would like to have a family photo taken at the same time. Grad Fees	 Your Graduation Activity Fee is \$47.05. All fees must be paid online through <u>School Cash Online</u>. Additional optional fees include: Winter Graduation Boat Cruise (approx. \$140 - \$160) Graduation Cap & Gown – Included in Grad Activity Fee Graduation Valedictory Ceremony– Free Graduation Banquet – TBD (approx. \$150-\$160)
Graduation Ceremony Profile	Each grade 12 will submit their profile write-up in their English 12 class. The Grade 12 Graduation Ceremony Profile is for every grade 12 student participating in the Grad Ceremony. It is read as they cross the stage at the venue. If students do not hand in a write-up, school administration will write something for them.
Valedictorian	Valedictorian candidates will submit nominations in the Spring (date TBD). To be considered as valedictorian students must: demonstrate positive citizenship, have excellent attendance, and be prepared to present 3 minutes of their speech to a panel of grad sponsors and school administration for consideration for Valedictorian.
Grad Council	Grad Council is sponsored by Ms. Yeo and Ms. Eyton. Grade 12 students on Grad Council were selected by their peers to represent their grad class in June 2023. They meet every Tuesday at lunch to discuss school activities, fundraisers and multiple grad events. Some of Seycove's annual grad events are: dress-up days, grad boat cruise (December), grad snack store, grad gift to school, Renaissance Award, fundraisers and helping shape the grad banquet and convocation. Graduation Ceremony Rehearsal & Gown Pick- up	The rehearsal for the Grade 12 Valedictory Ceremony will take place in the gym a few days ahead of the Valedictory Ceremony. <u>Attendance is compulsory for all participants!</u> Students will learn and practice the organization protocols for the ceremony. Grad gown order will be collected starting in early January 2024. All students participating in the Valedictory Ceremony will need to order and pick up their grad gowns and wear it to the Ceremony; the gown is their ticket into the event. Grad gown pick-up dates and times will be shared with grads closer to the date. <u>All outstanding school fees must be paid</u> in order to pick up your gown. Check your <u>School Cash Online</u> account to check and pay your school fees.



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Graduation Ceremony (June) June 18 th , 2024	 The Grade 12 Valedictory Ceremony will take place on June 18, 2024. Grads will need to be at the venue one hour before the ceremony begins. Grads must arrive wearing their gown as the gown is their ticket into the event. The entrance doors will open one hour before the ceremony. Tickets for family members to attend the event will be available in the month prior to the ceremony. Students will be provided a limit of 4 tickets. NO TICKETS WILL BE AVAILABLE AT THE DOOR. If you have guests that need special seating please contact Ms. Best. Formal Atmosphere: Audience should dress and conduct themselves in a manner appropriate to the formality of the occasion. Photography: Photographs of each grad will be taken on stage by Artona. Location for Graduation Ceremony to be determined.
Graduation Banquet (June) June 25 th , 2024 Pinnacle Hotel at the Pier (North Vancouver)	The Grade 12 Banquet will take place at the Pinnacle Hotel at the Pier, North Vancouver on Tuesday, June 25th. Tickets will go on sale online through school cash online at the beginning of May. NO TICKETS WILL BE SOLD AT THE DOOR. The ticket price will be approximately \$150-\$160 per ticket; everyone requires a ticket to attend. Seating must be chosen after tickets are purchased and all grads must have paid before a whole table can be reserved. It is best to pre-organize seating with friends and family. More information to come closer to the date. A group photo of all the grads will be taken prior to the the Banquet at the Pier at the North Vancouver Shipyards. The Grad Banquet is a dry event and security guards are onsite to ensure all graduates are in compliance. There are <u>no in and out</u> privileges.
