Photography 11 is a course open to all grade 10, 11 and 12 students.

In this course, you will learn many, many skills that will help you take, make, and edit photos. You will be using a digital single lens reflex camera (slr) in and out of class to understand how a camera works. (Seycove has many cameras available for students to borrow, or you may wish to bring your own.)

You will learn what makes a great photograph, and how to compose images that stand out from the ordinary, regardless of what camera they were taken on. You will be introduced to different styles of photography, and learn why some photographers are known the world around and become household names.

Students will learn about digital organization, and how to not only edit their images in Adobe Photoshop, but how to create stand-alone works of art in Photoshop as well. Although this course deals mostly with digital imaging, if time permits, you'll have the opportunity to use a 35mm black and white film camera at the end of the year, and print photos you've taken in the Seycove darkroom.
