The application period for academies begins on Friday, January 19, 2024 and ends February 29, 2024. The initial placement offer deadline is Thursday, February 29. Applications received after February 29, 2024 may be placed on a waitlist. Final academy offerings are subject to sufficient enrolment.

Submitting an application form represents interest in attending a North Vancouver School District Academy. Placement in an academy program is based on availability, in the event interest in an academy is greater than available positions, the following priorities will be offered conditional acceptance:

- Priority 1: Returning Students
- Priority 2: Wait-listed students from previous year
- Priority 3: Lottery of remaining students per Board Policy 605: Admission of Students to Schools.
