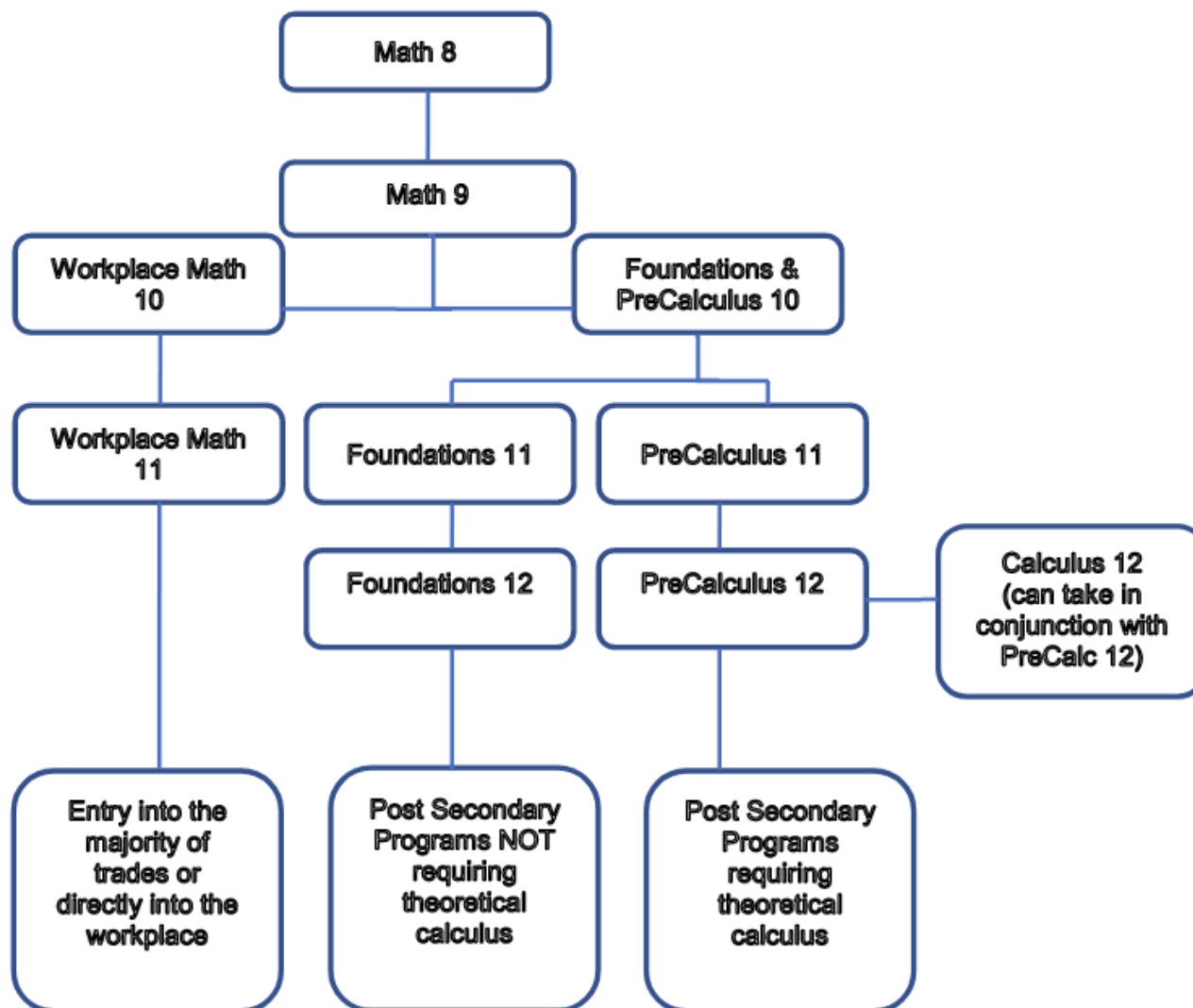

WHAT IS THE WEX COURSE?

- Work Experience or WEX has 2 levels - 12a and 12b.
- Each WEX course is considered an elective
- WEX is done outside the timetable - can be done during a spare
- Each WEX course is worth 4 credits. You need 80 credits to graduate.
- You can take it in grade 10, 11 or 12. You just need to be age 14 or older
- WEX placements let you try out working in a career of your choice
- You'll need 90 hours of work at your placement
- WEX students get great experience and references from their placements
