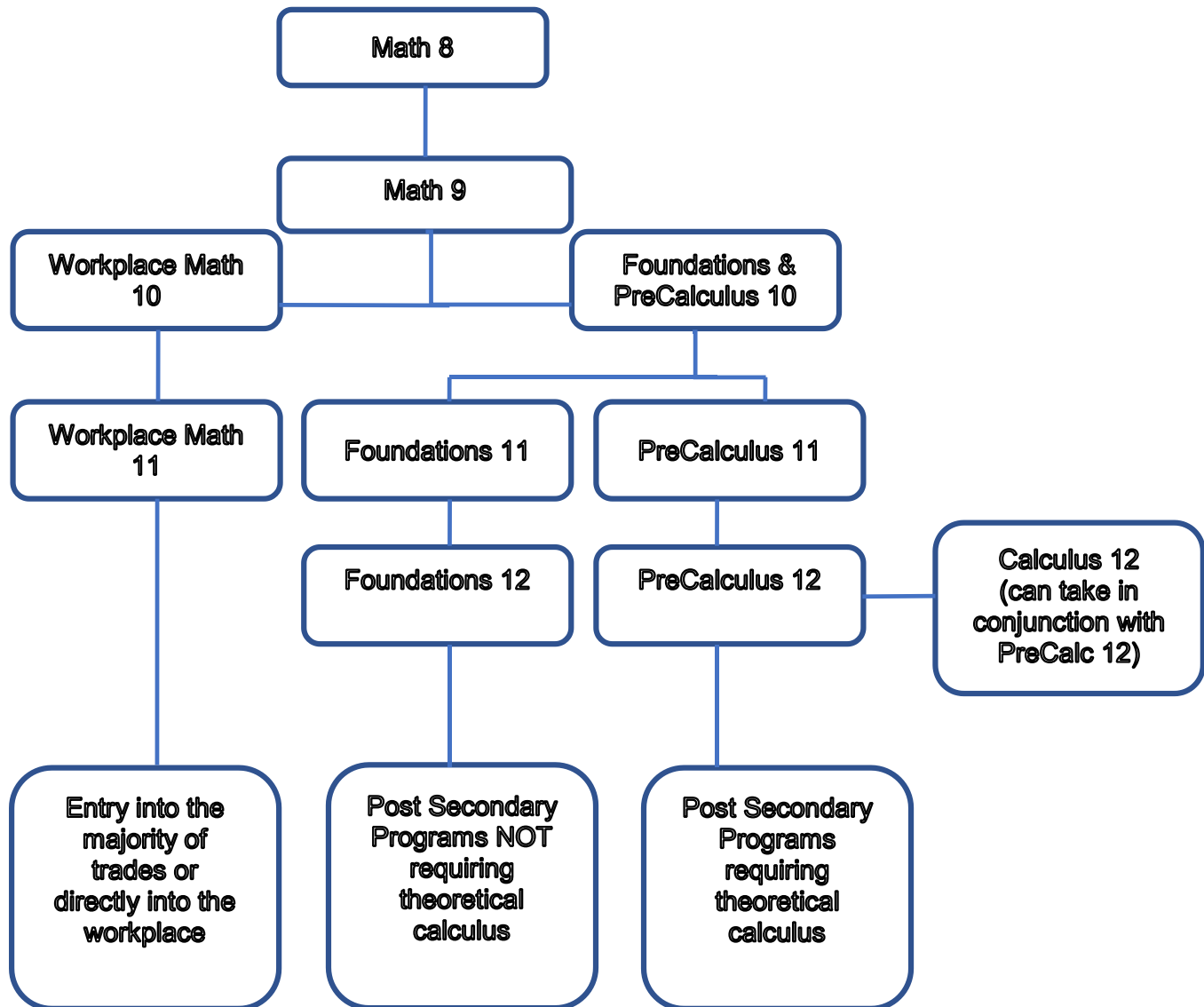

BC Ministry of Education Graduation Requirements

Students must earn a minimum of 80 credits: required credits (48), elective credits (28), and Career Life Education 12 (4). Listed below are the requirements for graduation. BEYOND 80 CREDITS: Eighty credits represents the minimum necessary for graduation. We encourage students to take full advantage of the opportunity to take a variety of courses to complete up to 96 credits (a full course load for grades 10–12).


