ASSESSMENT Policies

On-Going Formative Assessments

- The primary purpose of formative assessment is to communicate student learning and progress, identify areas for further growth, and provide a recipe for future success.
- Teachers in the Summer Learning program provide timely, specific and meaningful feedback to students in order to enhance their academic progress and self-efficacy
- Students will be active participants in the assessment of their learning by engaging in ongoing reflection and self-assessment aligned with Curricular and Core Competencies.

Class-Based Final Summative Assessments

- The primary purpose of a class-based summative assessment is to evaluate individual student learning throughout the course.
- **Class-based summative assessments will be on the last day of *Summer Learning* classes.** There are no exceptions to this.
- **All students must attend the final day of class** to satisfy requirements for completion of the course.
