SUMMER LEARNING POLICY



DRUGS, ALCOHOL, SMOKING, VAPING,

DRUGS & ALCOHOL

The use, possession, or distribution of illegal or restricted substances, including alcohol, is not permitted and will result in suspension from school. Students are not to be in the presence of others using illegal or restricted substances. Consumption of drugs or alcohol is forbidden on any school premises and at any school-sponsored event. Students should be aware that association with or even suspicion of involvement in these activities may result in disciplinary action.

There is a zero tolerance policy for students who are under the influence of, or in possession of, drugs and/or alcohol.

SMOKING and VAPING

In accordance with the Tobacco and Vapour Products Control Act and Regulation, the School District is responsible for enforcing the prohibition of smoking or any other tobacco use on school property. Smoking and Vaping anywhere on school property is strictly prohibited. This includes vehicles, parking lots, sports fields, driveways, courtyards, and private vehicles parked on school property. This policy applies to the use of e-cigarettes, electronic smoking products and cartridges of nicotine and/or flavoured solutions, and related products.

There is a zero tolerance policy for students who are vaping on school property.
