### EXAM Policies

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#### **Class-Based Final Summative Assessments**

- The primary purpose of a class-based summative assessment is to evaluate individual student learning throughout the course.
- Class-based summative assessments will be on the last day of *Summer Learning* classes. There are no exceptions to this.
- Final assessments are weighted at 20% of the final mark.

**Students who do not write the final assessment will be given a mark of zero, which will be calculated into the final mark.**

#### **Provincial Exam Policy**

To participate in the *Summer Learning* provincial exam session students must:

- be enrolled in a *Summer Learning* course
- be registered for the August Provincial Exam session
- bring their Personal Education Number (PEN) to the exam session
- bring two pieces of photo identification (no photo identification = no writing)
  - Go Cards are not accepted
- arrive in the exam room 30 minutes prior to the start of exams
- remain in the exam room for a minimum of 1 hour after the start of the exam

**Those students who fail to adhere to the above exam rules will not be permitted to write the exam.**

A final exam schedule will be posted on the *Summer Learning* website in July.

- All August Provincial Examinations are written in electronic format in the *Summer Learning* school computer lab.
- Students who miss the August examination may choose to write in October or November.
- Students must register for October or November exams with their home school.
- Credit for summer courses that have a Provincial Exam will only be granted upon the successful completion of both the course and the required provincial examination.
- The August Provincial Exam Session is for North Vancouver Summer School students only.
