Students are asked to attend by invitation or appointment only (please contact teacher directly for appointments). Beginning on Monday, February 1st, students will be in their new Quarter 3 classes. Along with that switch we also switch back to the AM cohort schedule for students in Grades 9-12 (mornings are full time face to face instruction: see chart below for schedule details). Quarter 3 teachers will be reaching out to students via MS Teams this week to welcome them to their new course and to provide any information needed ahead of the first class on Monday. Final report cards for Quarter 2 will be published to the MyEd Parent Portal on February 8th.

Key Safety Protocols

As we move into the next quarter, students are asked to familiarize themselves with their class location and designated entrances/exits for their new classes as they develop their new routines.

We are appreciative of the ongoing attention to safety protocols students are following when at school. Things like mask wearing indoors and distancing in common areas have become part of our basic regular practice and expectations. We also continue to encourage students to wear their mask outdoors, particularly when it is difficult to distance from others (such as before/after school and breaks).

All third quarter classes will review an updated safety re-orientation next week. This presentation can be found on our website under the 2020 New Info tab.

As a reminder, below are additional steps we have previously shared and continue to request students follow to increase safety at school:

- Please do not arrive early students should be arriving (just) on time for their 9:30 (or earlier scheduled) class, or time of their booked tutorial appointment with a teacher please do not arrive more than 5 or 10 minutes early to their scheduled school start time. Students are also expected to leave school grounds promptly after their class and to avoid gathering in groups. Unfortunately, at this time, the school and grounds are not a place to gather.
- Go directly to designated entrance when students gather in front of the main entrance to the school, this undermines the purpose of the zone entrances and creates an unsafe space. Students should wait for the bell to ring outside of their class' designated entrance. Students are not permitted to cross between zones within the building and are required to leave the building from the designated exit for their zone.
- Ensure distancing both inside and outside the school even when outside of assigned entrances, students need to be maintaining physical distance and wearing masks. In hallways and throughout the school, students must <u>ALWAYS WEAR A MASK</u> and be maintaining physical distance, in particular when eating lunch.
