Since the Campaign began over 10 years ago, thousands of communities and schools across Canada have held annual Moose Hide Campaign events and joined the annual ceremony and fast. People of all ages, genders and backgrounds are invited to take part in Moose Hide Campaign activities. A cornerstone of the Moose Hide Campaign is the moose hide pin. These pins will be handed out next week during tutorial time and at lunch by the front entrance of the school. Wearing the pin signifies your commitment to honour, respect, and protect the women and children in your life and speak out against gender-based and domestic violence.
