CAROLINE HELBIG ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP AWARD \$1,000

Awarded to a student graduating from a public secondary school on Vancouver's North Shore, who will be pursuing studies in the areas of environmental conservation, stewardship or advanced environmental research in a post-secondary institution in Canada. Demonstrated commitment to environmental issues, passion for the outdoors and addressing environmental concerns. Be available for an interview if requested by the award committee. Essay requirement.



CHRISTINA LAWSON SCHOLARSHIP IN MUSIC AND DRAMA \$2,000



Awarded to a student who has demonstrated involvement in music and/or drama pursuits and is committed to including these as part of their career plan. Must be a North Shore resident - includes Bowen Island, Lions Bay, North and West Vancouver and attending a public North Shore school. Must be enrolling in a Canadian or US post-secondary institution. Preference given to enrollment in Canada. Essay requirement.

DARRIN MORRISON FUND FOR VISUAL ARTS & ARCHITECTURE \$1,000

Awarded to a public high school student on the North Shore (North or West Vancouver) that has been accepted to a post-secondary institution focusing on the study of the visual arts or architecture. The applicant will reflect the qualities that Darrin Morrison brought to his stewardship of the West Vancouver Art Museum - an excellent understanding of art and design, an astute, critical mind and a strong vision that brings ideas to reality. Selection will be made on a combination of academic and artistic merit. Essay and portfolio requirement.



GERTRUDE LAWSON SCHOLARSHIP IN EDUCATION - \$2,000

Awarded to a graduating student who is committed to teaching/education as a career. Preference given to those planning to teach in BC., and who are enrolling in a Canadian post-secondary institution. Must be a North Shore resident (includes Bowen Island, Lions Bay, North and West Vancouver) and attending a public North Shore school. Essay requirement.



HARTVIKSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP IN MEMORY OF LOURDES LLAMZON - \$1,000 - per year up to 4 years

Awarded to a student (Canadian or International), that is enrolling in a post-secondary institution in Canada studying sustainable agriculture and food systems, and who possesses the character and qualities exemplified by Lourdes Llamzon: dedication to family and community, athletic commitment, high academic achievement, and a passion for sustainable and ethical agriculture. Essay requirement.

JEREMY DALTON RUGBY ENDOWMENT AWARD - \$2,500

Awarded to two North Shore students who are Capilano Rugby Club members and who best display the personal attributes that were so important in Jeremy's life; academic ambition, community spirit and a love of rugby. Must be enrolling or currently in a recognized post-secondary or trade institution in BC or Canada. Essay requirement.



MICHAEL SHARP "SHARPIE" HOCKEY SCHOLARSHIP - \$1,000

Awarded to a student graduating from a public secondary school on Vancouver's North Shore and proceeding to a post-secondary institution in Canada. Consistent involvement in ice hockey programs on the North Shore along with evidence of a sincere desire to help others, along with demonstrated integrity in your studies and extracurricular activities. Be available for interview with the scholarship committee, if selected as a candidate.
Essay and interview requirement.



TRAJAN MARTIN MEMORIAL AWARD \$1,000

Awarded to a student residing on Vancouver's North Shore aged 16-25, who demonstrates compassion, adventure, integrity and exuberance for life and is enrolling in a post-secondary institution in Canada. Essay requirement.



VANEE SCHOLARSHIP FUND - \$1,000

Awarded to a student graduating from a public or independent secondary school on Vancouver's North Shore and proceeding to a post-secondary program, with preference given to the field of study in either Architecture or Engineering, who has outstanding academic achievement and demonstrated school leadership or community service. Essay requirement. Must be available for an interview with Mr. and Mrs. Vanee, if selected as a candidate.



YOUTH PHILANTHROPY \$1,500

Awarded to a high school student on the North Shore (North or West Vancouver) that has been accepted to a post-secondary institution. The applicant will demonstrate commitment to community service, social impact, and compassionate leadership. This scholarship supports students who not only volunteer their time but actively work to create sustainable positive change.
