Dear Parents/Guardians of Grade 7 Students,

On behalf of the staff and current students at Sutherland, welcome!

It is with great anticipation that we look forward to the arrival of our new Grade 8s this coming September. As we prepare to welcome the Grad Class of 2030, Sutherland staff will engage in thorough consultation with elementary school classroom teachers, administrators, learning support teachers, and counsellors. The Grade 7-8 Transition process is designed to provide Sutherland staff with the information we need to best support our incoming students but is also how we convey essential information and offer opportunities to students and guardians to become more familiar with the school community.

<u>Course Programming Information Meeting for Grade 7 Parents/Guardians: Thursday, February 6, 2025, from 5:30pm – 7:00pm at Sutherland Secondary School</u>

Parents of current Grade 7s are invited to Sutherland for a course programming information and transition meeting on Thursday, February 6th, 2025. This presentation will be hosted by Ms. Samantha Lo (Grade 8 Counsellor) and Ms. Shannon Smart (Grade 8 Vice Principal). In the presentation, we will include general information about high school as well as specific information about Sutherland. The primary purpose of this meeting is to provide information about the Sutherland Grade 8 course offerings and programs available. We will introduce the Course Request sheets and give information about how to support students in completing these forms. An optional school tour will start at 5:30pm and the presentation will begin in the Cafeteria at 6:00pm.

<u>Grade 7 Student Programming Presentations: February 24-28 at Elementary Schools</u>

Samantha Lo (Grade 8 Counsellor) and Shannon Smart (Grade 8 Vice-Principal) will be visiting Grade 7 classes at our in-catchment elementary schools – Eastview, Brooksbank, Ridgeway, and Queensbury – in late February. Topics will include Grade 8 course request options, programs and offerings at Sutherland, extra-curricular opportunities, and general information about attending secondary school. We will hand out Course Request forms at these meetings. Please work with your student to complete and return their form to your child's Grade 7 teacher by Friday, March 7, 2025.

Grade 7 Student Orientation and Tour of Sutherland

We will host each Grade 7 class and their teacher at Sutherland in April. Senior Sutherland leadership students will guide groups on a tour of the school. Students will have a chance to see the various elective areas, academic areas, applied skills areas, as well as student support areas of the school.
