Empowering Parents: Promoting Parental Well-Being to Manage Childhood Anxiety

We are all anxious. I don't think we used to be so anxious, but in our fast-paced, post-Covid world, it seems we are all carrying more anxiety than we used to - including our kids.

Please join me on Monday, October 16th, at 7pm at Upper Lynn Elementary where we'll discuss recognizing the signs of childhood anxiety and how to offer effective support. We'll also explore managing our own parental anxiety, a crucial but often overlooked aspect of family life.

During this session you'll gain a deeper understanding of the environmental causes and biological mechanisms of anxiety, as well as practical tools to promote resilience, open communication, and reduce anxiety within yourself and your family. Please come with your questions as we will have time for discussion.

You are not alone in this journey, and together, we can create a more relationally balanced and mentally healthy community for us all.

Tyler Milley is a proud Upper Lynn parent and registered clinical counsellor with over 25 years of experience supporting children and parents overcoming anxiety and thriving with various types of neurodiversity. 
