# Upper Lynn News

#### Halloween

Halloween is fast approaching. Upper Lynn will be having a Sing-along, a parade, and each class will recognize Halloween in its own way.

#### Costumes:

Students may wear their costumes to school, or they may wish to dress for the day in Halloween colours of orange and/or black. Please be mindful of cultural appropriation, remember someone else's culture isn't a costume! Students will be permitted to wear their costumes throughout the day. If the costume includes face make up, please ensure your child comes to school with it already on their face.

#### Weapons/Masks:

For safety reasons, please no swords, guns or real or pretend weapons or fragile items. We are also asking that the costumes not be too scary for the younger students.

#### Candy:

In keeping with our exploration of the Health Curriculum and healthy treats being saved for "once in a while" please ensure that your child brings only one candy per day for the week following Halloween. #### Colour Guard Needed for Remembrance Day Assembly

On Friday, November 10, at 10:50 am we will be holding our Remembrance Day Assembly. We invite all students who participate in service organizations such as Sparks, Brownies, Cubs, Scouts, Cadets and Guides, to help mark the occasion by wearing their full uniforms to the assembly on this day. The students who do wear their uniform will play a very important role in the assembly. We ask that the students bring a change of clothes to change into before they go out for lunch. Later this week, classroom teachers will be talking to their students about the assembly and be asking for student involvement. Information will be sent home with those students who are interested in participating in the colour guard.

#### Mobile Devices at School

Students who need immediate communication with parents regarding getting to school or home from school may utilize a mobile device before 8:30 or after 3:00 pm on the school grounds. Students will be asked to keep their mobile devices in backpacks and not to use them when on the school grounds unless they are working on assignments where staff members have allowed the use of this technology. This is always under direct supervision of a staff member.

As well, the use of an Apple Watch (or similar device) could potentially create distractions and tempt children to use them for non-educational purposes during class time, hindering their focus on learning. Moreover, the presence of expensive devices like Apple Watches may increase the risk of theft or inequality among students who do not have access to such technology.

Please consult with your child's teacher if you have any questions about mobile device use in their classrooms. The school telephone is available for all emergency situations. For any mobile device to be on school property, the parent and student must sign the mobile technology agreement.

#### **Student Reporting**

Your child's Student Learning Update will be made accessible on the portal in mid-December. The Ministry of Education and Childcare has produced <u>resources (https://bit.ly/3MySNox</u>) to help parents and caregivers understand the changes in how student progress will be shared, including an Information Package for Parents and Caregivers on Communicating Student Learning, available in eight languages, and a presentation by ministry staff on K-12 student reporting in British Columbia. #### Appropriate Clothing and Footwear

Autumn is here and the weather is changing. Please remember to send your children to school in appropriate clothing and footwear to keep them warm and comfortable on these cold and rainy days. Sending an extra set of clothes to leave at school and a pair of indoor shoes is also suggested to enable them to stay dry and warm even on the wettest of North Van days!

#### Drop-Off

As we move into the cooler months, we just wanted to take a moment to remind everyone of the rules regarding parking around our school that help keep all children and adults safe.

The Drop-Off / Pick-Up Zone immediately in front of the school is a no parking zone. This area is designated for dropping off and picking up only. No car should be in the space for more than one minute and no vehicle should ever be parked without a driver. Also, please be reminded to not park in, or have children walk through, the staff parking lot before school, during school, or after school. Please be respectful of the rules around the school for the safety of all our children.
