To raise kids who are stable, resilient and emotionally intelligent, we need to show them how to manage their emotions in a healthy way. In GRIT for Parents we explore the development of kids' brains, the neuro-science of calm, and the concept of self-regulation through co-regulation. This is a fun, lighthearted and interactive workshop.



Alix is a certified mindfulness facilitator and mental health advocate. She comes from 25yrs of teaching young people, and developed the program Grit in 2015 to address the youth anxiety epidemic. Since then,

she's grown Grit Workshops throughout Greater Vancouver and leads in-school programming, camps and workshops for kids, youth and adults.
