What is this Extra-curricular club?

- DSLC is often described as the "Student Council" of District 44 and the VOICE of North Vancouver students
- DSLC is a group of highly engaged and active students who meet regularly to provide **leadership**, **voice** and **student perspective** on education issues in our schools
- **DSLC represents students** providing youth perspective on Committees, at Board Meetings, and at many events both locally and throughout the Lower Mainland
- We **connect to schools and the School District** in different ways the most important is at general meetings where we talk with other students, also reps on school committees, and meetings with School Trustees
- We host **General Meetings** every month or so after school from 3:45 5:15pm rotating between all secondary schools. There is a free transportation service if you need it to and from meetings to home school.
- At General meetings, we discuss **educational topics** so that we can become informed of the issues that impact our learning and can better represent students and provide our voice
- This is a great chance to meet and network with students of all ages from all schools!
- Membership is Free and completely open to those who are in grade 8-12. Only rule is that you must be curious!

What we need from you...

- Your Voice, Energy and Curiosity for 90 minutes after school once a month or so to connect with other students
- Your **unique ideas** we really want **diverse thinkers** of all grades and schools for broad perspective. If you say that schools could be better this is your chance to have you say!
- The more you are involved, the more you can get out of the experience. General members can come as much as they can to be connected, but there is no expectation of attendance. We encourage students to invite friends to join them.
- Executive members (2 reps per school) do have much greater commitment expectations
