General Information

 Course Programming begins! The Parent Course Programming presentation will be in the multipurpose room on Thurs Jan 23rd at 7 pm for families to garner information on Course Info and basic university requirements.

Grade assemblies also will be held at **8:30 am** with the same power point information plus the Course Selection sheets:

- a. Grade 11 into 12 Mon Jan 20th
- b. Grade 10 into 11 Tues Jan 21st
- c. Grade 9 into 10 Wed Jan 22nd
- d. Grade 8 into 9 Thurs Jan 23rd

Please take the time to inquire and explore your course planning options by then in order to make good decisions. Counsellors are here to help. The timetable is built around those selections, and we cannot always accommodate changes later in the spring or in the fall if courses fill up.

All grade 9-11 students will input the courses on their own by Fri Feb 28th. The window for course selection input online opens on Feb 3rd. Grade 8's will use class time during Period 6 from Feb 24, 26 and 28 to input their courses to the computer, with support. All students need to hand in their Course Request forms AFTER they have input their own course selections into the computer, by Feb 28th at the latest. If students need help, they can bring their forms to the Review/Completion Day on March 4th and staff will

help them input courses in the Library Lab from 10 am – noon. We keep the forms on file for reference. Students will receive instructions closer to the input window.

 Students who missed, or wish to rewrite any Assessments, must see their grade counsellor. Assessment results are not used for university admissions (with the exception of UBC which looks at Lit 12 Assessment) and are reported on a scale of 1-4.

There are 6 different criteria to find a program most in line with your goals. This is a great time of year to explore, since course programming is due soon! You can click links to bring you to "Admissions Info" such as this for Human Kinetics: Human Kinetics (Cap) or this for Architecture at BCIT: Architecture BCIT Grades 12's can use this Education Planner site to apply to post secondary schools directly.

You do not need to go directly to BCIT ... you can get Trades info and training through the College of the BC Building Trades College of the BC Building Trades It is an association of training providers, with more than a dozen trade-specific schools. Explore the different trades online. Excellent resource and excellent job prospects in this area.

- 1. If you missed the booking for your Grad photo, Grads BC will open one more date in the New Year, but a **retake** session is Jan 6th for those of you who already did one sitting.
- 2. Transcripts Site: www.studenttranscripts.gov.bc.ca This was your assignment in your CLC Course, Unit 4.1. Click on "Current Student" and follow instructions to create an account. No matter where you apply, you MUST GIVE CONSENT on the STS site by Jan 31st to "Send Interim and Final Marks when Available", for anywhere in North America to ensure that your official marks get sent in February (term one) and July (final marks). Otherwise, you will lose your offer. See your full transcript with interim marks under "Preview" where you chose the PSI's to receive your marks. (It is a confusing site, since those grade 12 marks do not show up under "View My Transcript" for some strange reason). If a university requires a paper or digital copy from the school, students should see your counsellor. - 4. Important Application Deadlines for BC Post Secondary Schools:
 - UBC Jan 15th (for eligibility for Entrance scholarships was Dec 1st)
 - Emily Carr U of Art/Design Jan 15th
 - SFU Jan 31st
 - UVIC Jan 31st
 - UNBC Jan 15th for Entrance Awards, otherwise Feb 1st March 31st
 - Capilano U depends on the program
 - BCIT Jan 15 April 30th, depending on program. Gr 11's can apply now though! Some programs have waitlists of 18 months.
 - Kwantlen Polytechnic U March 1st

- Thompson Rivers University: Jan 31st(Nursing) or Feb 1st (Resp. Therapy/Vet Tech) or May 1st for other programs.
