Grads

- 1. The Ministry of Education does NOT send a final transcript to homes in the summer. You need to extract it from the STS site before the end of December after graduation, otherwise you will have to pay \$10 for each download. Please print out your final transcript for personal use for free in the next 6 months. See: www.studenttranscripts.gov.bc.ca and click on "Current Student", then scroll down to "login to Student Transcripts". The \$10 fee will be removed in the last step if it is ordered before the end of December.
- 2. Graduates are *required* at our <u>Graduation Rehearsal</u> in the main gym at **8:30 am on <u>Wed June 18th</u>**, during Tutorial time. Grad caps, gowns and tickets to the Orpheum (4 per family) will be issued at that time, assuming that grad fees have been paid.

<u>Starting on June 1st</u>, more tickets can be purchased for \$10 each in the main office or at the door at the Orpheum. Grads are also required at <u>6:15 pm at the Orpheum on Friday June 20th</u> for the Graduation

- Ceremony. Please see the list of "To do's" inserted into each grad gown package for more details regarding the day.
- 3. The Grad Banquet is set to go on **Saturday June 21**st at the Vancouver Convention Centre. We look forward to seeing all graduates for a group photo outside the venue at 5:15 pm. Doors open at 6 pm.
