Grads

1. The Ministry of Education does NOT send a final transcript to homes in the summer. You need to extract it from the STS site before the end of December after graduation, otherwise you will have to pay \$10 for each download. Please print out your final transcript for personal use for free in the next 6 months. See: www.studenttranscripts.gov.bc.ca and click on "Current Student", then scroll down to "login to Student Transcripts". The \$10 fee will be removed in the last step if it is ordered before the end of December.

2. Students who are planning to attend Post Secondary Institutes this coming fall need to make their PSI selections (to have their final transcript sent) by July 15th through the [Student Transcripts Service \(STS\)](#). Students may select up to 25 PSI's for free transcripts to be digitally sent, and one free mailed to any address. Additional transcripts cost \$10 each.
3. The Windsor Graduation ceremony is Tuesday June 2nd at 7 pm. Each family received 4 tickets, if grad fees were paid, but extra tickets can be purchased for \$10 each in the main office or at the door at the Orpheum. Grads are also required at **6:15 pm at the Orpheum** and enter from the Granville entrance. Please see the list of "To do's" inserted into each grad gown package for more details regarding the day.
4. The Grad Banquet is set to go on **Saturday June 20th** at the Vancouver Convention Centre. We look forward to seeing all graduates for a group photo outside the venue at 5:15 pm. Doors open at 6 pm. With all grad events, and the World Cup situation, please leave extra time due to road closures and traffic.
5. Our scholarship committee of 12 staff members have selected bursary and scholarship recipients, which will be announced at the Grad ceremony. However, the actual cheques/official pieces will be given out in the counselling office on the following days: **Tues June 9th or Thursday June 11th in tutorial time or after school from the counselling office.** Students will be asked to bring their Thank You letter or do one on site, and Honourarium forms.
