2. The last day to register for Online courses through North Vancouver Online is June 6<sup>th</sup>. Registration will then open on Sept 2<sup>nd</sup>.

## End of year

1. Students who have completed service hours WITHIN Windsor need to have their **Windsor Service Credit hours form**, which is available for pick-up from the main office, or is located on the school website at the bottom of this page: [Forms - École Windsor Secondary \(sd44.ca\)](https://www.sd44.ca/forms) . The signed form needs to be handed in by **Friday May 15<sup>th</sup>** for consideration. Service hours are accumulated over a student's time at Windsor and there are Service awards at year end. Volunteer hours done outside of school are for personal record, and are excellent for scholarships, resumes and university applications, but we do not track those. 30 hours of paid or unpaid work, outside of school, are required for graduation as part of Career Life Ed 12.
2. Final assessments occur in many courses, so please be aware that classes go until June 19<sup>th</sup>, with many courses having final tests and exams that week. Yearbooks will be given out on Wednesday June 24<sup>th</sup>, with more information in coming weeks.
3. Numeracy 10 Assessment and Literacy 12 rewrites, plus any missed Literacy 10 Assessments from April will take place the week of June 10<sup>th</sup> Please contact your counsellor should you wish a rewrite or if you missed it.

**To see and download a copy of your child's results for either the Gr10 or Gr12 Assessments** - Go to [www.studenttranscripts.gov.bc.ca](http://www.studenttranscripts.gov.bc.ca) (don't be thrown by the info re transcripts, you are on the right page)

Click on "Current Student"

Then either Register for a Basic Account or Login if you already have one. You will need your child's information as noted on the page.

You will receive an email via the email you entered (should be child's). Click the link in the email to confirm

Then you can login and you will see Assessments and Results among other items in the Dashboard. You can view or download PDF.

4. Summer Learning registration begins online **May 1<sup>st</sup> at 9 am!** Full credit courses, whether to get ahead or to catch up are offered during the month of July. Please follow this link for further information:
