5. Service Hours Awards: for students who have contributed to **school service** in activities such as club executive positions, peer tutoring, coaching, fruit delivery, or hours completed as part of service clubs (fundraising, providing school tours with Ambassadors, parking lot attendants, parent teacher interview managers, working with special needs students, etc.) Recognition is given to students accumulating the following hours over the course of their **entire** time at Windsor:
- a. 30 – 99 hours = Service Certificate
 - b. 100-199 hours = Bronze Medal
 - c. 200 – 299 hours = Silver Medal
 - d. 300-399 = Gold Medal
 - e. 400 – 499 = Bronze Plaque
 - f. 500 – 599 = Silver Plaque
 - g. 600 – 699 = Gold Plaque
 - h. 700+ = Platinum Plaque

Students are encouraged to complete this form each year if they have School Service Hours: [service tracker](#) , due by **May 16th** to the office. School Service is DIFFERENT from the 30 hours of Work Exposure (paid or unpaid work in the wider community, from grade 10-12) that is required for Careers 12. Grade 12's can complete the required 30 hours document through their CLC 12 course.
