Re: Course Programming Process and Parent Information Evenings

We would like to invite you to our upcoming Course Programming Parent Information Meetings. All meetings will be held in the Windsor Cafeteria.

Wednesday, January 24^{th} at 7:00pm (for current Grade 8-11 students) Tuesday, January 30^{th} at 7:00pm with optional school tour at 6:30pm (for current Grade 7 students)

The purpose of these meetings is to review the process for students to select courses for the 2024-2025 school year and to provide an overview to parents on factors to consider when you are assisting your student(s) with their course selection decisions.

The course programming process is multi-faceted and requires careful consideration and planning. After our counsellors have provided initial information to parents and students, we request that you continue to discuss various course options, consider student strengths and interests, talk to Windsor teachers about their course offerings (content, topics, rigor, etc.), contact post-secondary intuitions for admission requirements if necessary, and ask clarifying questions of school counsellors.

As we begin to receive student course requests and build our timetable for next year, there are two main factors that affect a student's schedule:

- The courses that will be offered next year are subject to change based on enrolment
- Students may not be able to receive all requested courses due to scheduling conflicts

Therefore, please be sure to have your student(s) include alternate course choices on their course programming sheet. It is also important to emphasize that course changes will most likely not be possible in September 2024 so it is essential that we engage in comprehensive and accurate course planning. Next years' timetable will be built on the requests provided this spring.
