Between February 2nd and March 6th, current grade 8 – 11 students will go through our Windsor course programming process with their grade counsellors and administrators.

Students will be received Course Programming information at Grade Assemblies starting at **9:00am** on the following dates:

Current Grade 11 students: Thursday, February 2nd at 9:00am

Current Grade 10 students: Friday, February 3rd at 9:00am

Current Grade 9 students: Monday, February 6th at 9:00am

Current Grade 8 students: Tuesday, February 7th at 9:00am

Between February 13th and 24th, Grade counsellors will be visiting Period 6 classes to deliver **Individualized Course Request forms** for current Grade 9-11 students. **These forms will have important login information for electronic input purposes.**

Grade 9-11 students will be expected to input their course requests into MyEd BC between February 27th and March 5th at home. Instructions for course input will also be available on our website starting February 24th. If needed, extra support for course input will be offered during morning Tutorial Time between March 1st and 3rd (8:30-9:12 am in the Library Lab). Students are to complete, have parent/guardian signature and hand in their individualized course request form to student services no later than **March 6th**.

Current Grade 8 students will be inputting their course requests at school with the help of their Grade counsellor and their Period 6 teachers between March 1st and 3rd.

Current Grade 7 students within the Windsor Family of Schools, will continue to receive any further course programming or grade 7/8 transition information through their classroom teacher.
