## Post Secondary Program Requirements

- Typical Science or Engineering Programs require 2 Grade 12 Sciences PLUS Physics 11
- Typical Humanities / Arts Programs require 4-5 Grade 12 Academic course (may include Sciences)
- Typical Commerce program requires PreCalculus 12 (Calculus 12 recommended)
- Each PSI sets their own requirements and these may change without notice!
